Greetings my sisters in Christ,

Just a friendly reminder to pay your dues for 2024. If your parish has fulfilled this obligation, please disregard this reminder.

In accordance with the by-laws of the Episcopal Church Women of the Diocese of Long Island please note:

- 1. The fiscal year begins on January 1st and ends on December 31st each year.
- 2. Monies received after December 15th will be credited to the next fiscal year.
- 3. Each parish shall make an annual contribution to support the diocesan budget of the ECW and donations from individuals will be gratefully accepted.
- 4. It is <u>suggested</u> that each participating parish contribute \$150, or as much as they are able, annually to support the budget.

Monies in the budget cover operating expenses such as the bonding of those who handle money, audits, postage, supplies, Triennial delegate expenses, handbooks, National and Province ECW dues etc.

I strongly urge you to support the budget so that the work of the board can be accomplished in a timely manner.

Diocese of Long Island The Episcopal Church Women Scholarship Application 2025 - Application Instructions

This application is to be completed by any woman (not just H.S. seniors) who wishes to pursue higher education and has been accepted for admission to an accredited college, community college, or vocational/trade school, in the United States for fall 2025. One scholarship will be awarded in each county.

Scholarship recipient will receive a financial award of \$500.00. Winners will be notified by June 1, 2025

To be eligible for the Scholarship, you must:

- Be a Baptized Member of an Episcopal/Anglican Church.
- You must have a High School or GED Diploma.
- Required to be in a parish within the Diocese of Long Island

You must submit a complete application packet with the following:

- Personal Information Form (See attachment)
- One letter of recommendation written by your Priest or Church Warden
- A typed written essay of 300 words or less of your involvement with your parish and/or the Episcopal Church
